

## What's New in the Student Academic Misconduct Policy (70)?

The revised Student Academic Misconduct policy (70) comes into effect with the start of the Fall 2019 semester and all allegations of academic misconduct will now be governed by this version. With the revision we have also separated the procedures and regulations from the Policy, and these are now published separately (see below for links). While we encourage all academic staff to read the new policy and regulations, there are significant changes and we would like to draw your attention to the following items in the procedures document:

Along with the changes in the policy and its regulations and procedures, there are some additional process changes.

In general, these changes are visually represented in the two attached Student Academic Misconduct Procedures Flowcharts. The first, called WHATS NEW, is highlighted in yellow to show significant process

changes at a glance. The second is also available for reference on the Office of the Registrar /Academic Integrity website.

To facilitate the new processes, the Notice of Disciplinary Action for Academic Misconduct has been revised. It is now a 2 sided form and both sides should be printed. The new notice is attached for reference.
